Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of Fort Bend County Emergency Services District #4 (the "District") will conduct a public hearing regarding the District's proposed 2019 tax rate at 8:30am on Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at the Fulshear Simonton Fire Department Station #1 located at 30626 5th Street, Fulshear, Texas. The public is invited to attend.

1. Establish quorum and call to order
2. Public Comment/Public Hearing on Proposed 2019 Tax Rate: Each member of the public who desires to address the Board regarding an item on the agenda may speak one time only and will be limited to *3 minutes* per speaker. If simultaneous translation equipment is not available, a member of the public who addresses the Board through a translator must be given *6 minutes* per speaker in order to ensure that non-English speakers receive the same opportunity to address the Board.

Each member of the public who desires to address the Board regarding an item not on the agenda may speak one time only and will be limited to *3 minutes* per speaker; responses to public comment about matters not on the agenda are limited by state law to a recitation of existing policy or a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation or decision by the Board shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda of a future meeting. If simultaneous translation equipment is not available, a member of the public who addresses the Board through a translator must be given *6 minutes* per speaker in order to ensure that non-English speakers receive the same opportunity to address the Board.
